

# **Post-Conference Executive Summary**

1st FIP Regional Conference on for the Eastern Mediterranean Region: "Envisioning the future together: Transforming pharmacy for better primary health care"

### 25 & 26 April 2019, Amman

- Following the 2018 WHO Astana Declaration on Primary Health Care, the global imperative for strengthening pharmacy's place in the delivery of primary health care has never been stronger.
- FIP, as the global leadership body for pharmacy, immediately identified partners and members and acted to bring together leaders and professionals across all regions of the world to progress this imperative and consolidate the role of pharmacy in the PHC agenda.
- FIP organised the 1st regional conference for the Eastern Mediterranean "Envisioning the future together: Transforming pharmacy for better primary health care" in partnership the Jordan Pharmacists Association (JPA), and supported by the EMRO Pharmaceutical Forum in Amman, Jordan on April 25 & 26.
- The aim of the conference was to draw colleagues together from across the EM Region to identify ways in
  which pharmacy can deliver Primary Healthcare in coming years, to achieve Universal Health Coverage
  across four areas of safety, non-communicable disease, prevention and workforce transformation. The
  outcomes were the first pharmacy commitment to deliver across the region, alongside plans for action in the
  four areas identified.
- Around 1200 pharmacy leaders and participants from more than 30 countries gathered to sign the FIRST pharmacy commitment to PHC as our collective response to the Astana Declaration: the "Amman Commitment to Action on Primary Health Care" to transform pharmacy for better primary health care.
- The conference, under the patronage of the Jordanian Prime Minister, received the full support of the WHO EMRO Regional Director Dr Ahmad Al Mandhari who delivered a <u>video message</u> to all participants. In addition, WHO EMRO was formally represented in person by its Technical Officer on Essential Medicines and Pharmaceuticals Adi Nuseirat.
- The theme of this conference builds on the Astana Declaration, with the Pharmacy Amman Commitment, emphasising unity in the region and highlighting the roles for pharmacy for the effectiveness of primary health care.
- High-level sessions feature primary health care best practices from the region and facilitated the mapping and prioritisation of practice, service and workforce development needs, which will inform a regional roadmap for action.
